Dr. Mimi Hoang (she/her)

Program Coordinator, AMCS LGBTQ+ Affirmative Therapy Center

Dr. Mimi Hoang (she/her) is an award-winning psychologist, life coach, and educator specializing in the LGBTQ+ and Asian American communities. Since the 1990s, she has co-founded three organizations for bisexual, pansexual, and fluid (AKA “bi+”) individuals – the Los Angeles Bi+ Task Force (LABTF), amBi Los Angeles, and Fluid at UCLA. Dr. Mimi has authored multiple publications and earned a seat at the landmark 2013 White House Bisexual Community Roundtable which sparked her focus on bi+ affirmative mental health. Her steadfast leadership has earned her multiple awards

and recognitions, including being named “One of the Most Significant Women in the Bisexual Movement.” Dr. Mimi is currently the owner of Living in Color Therapy, Program Coordinator of the LGBTQIA+ Affirmative Therapy Center at Airport Marina Counseling Services, and professor at the USC Marriage and Family Therapy Program. She continues to give back by serving pro-bono on three boards – Division VII of the California Psychological Association, LABTF, and Fluid Health.

Bamby Salcedo (she/her)

Transgender Latina activist

Bamby Salcedo is a prominent and celebrated transgender Latina activist, known all over the world for her passionate and productive social, political, and economic influence. As the President and CEO of the TransLatin@ Coalition, Bamby steadily leads this nationally recognized organization that advocates for and addresses the issues of transgender Latinas throughout the United States. Bamby received her Master's Degree in Mexican and Latin@ Studies from California State University, Los Angeles, and also developed the Center for Violence Prevention & Transgender Wellness, a multimillion, multipurpose, multiservice space for Trans people in Los Angeles.



Bamby's wide-ranging activist work has brought visibility and given a voice to not only the trans community, but to countless others whose efforts focus on critical topics that include immigration, HIV, at-risk youth, LGBTQIA+ issues, incarceration, and more. Through her dynamic leadership, Bamby has developed several organizations that have created networks and connections where there were none, and she, to this day, tirelessly advocates for the rights, dignity, and humanity of those who are often silenced. Determined to affect change at every level, Bamby actively engages and supports many local, national, and international organizations and planning groups.

PrideFest is open to the public and all members of the LGBTQIA+ community and allies

are welcome to attend. The goal of the event is to bring the community together to celebrate Pride, create a fun, safe, and supportive space for individuals to connect with mental health services and learn about the many resources available to them.
